



REFRACTION POLICY

The **REFRACTION** is an eye exam that measures a person's prescription for eyeglasses. It is also the most precise method in which the doctors can determine that your eyes are corrected for the best vision possible. If you are a new patient here, baseline refraction will most likely be performed today if you are not seeing 20/20 with your present glasses. If you are established patient and your vision is found to have decreased since your last refraction, a new refraction is recommended. You may or may not be given a prescription for new glasses based on the result of your refraction.

In the past, refractions were included in your complete eye exam. **Medicare and all other insurance companies have notified us that we can no longer include the refraction as part of your eye exam, and that we are required a charge. The amount is \$50 for this service.**
